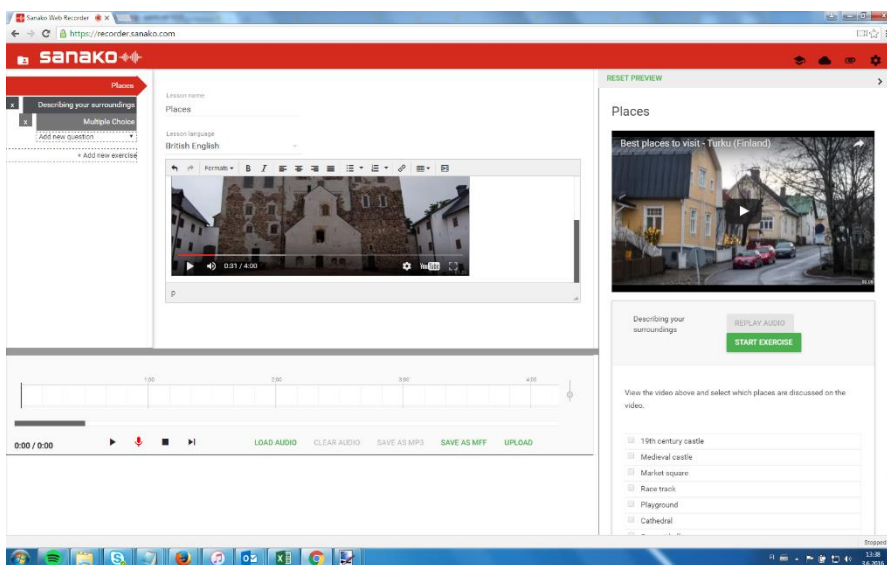


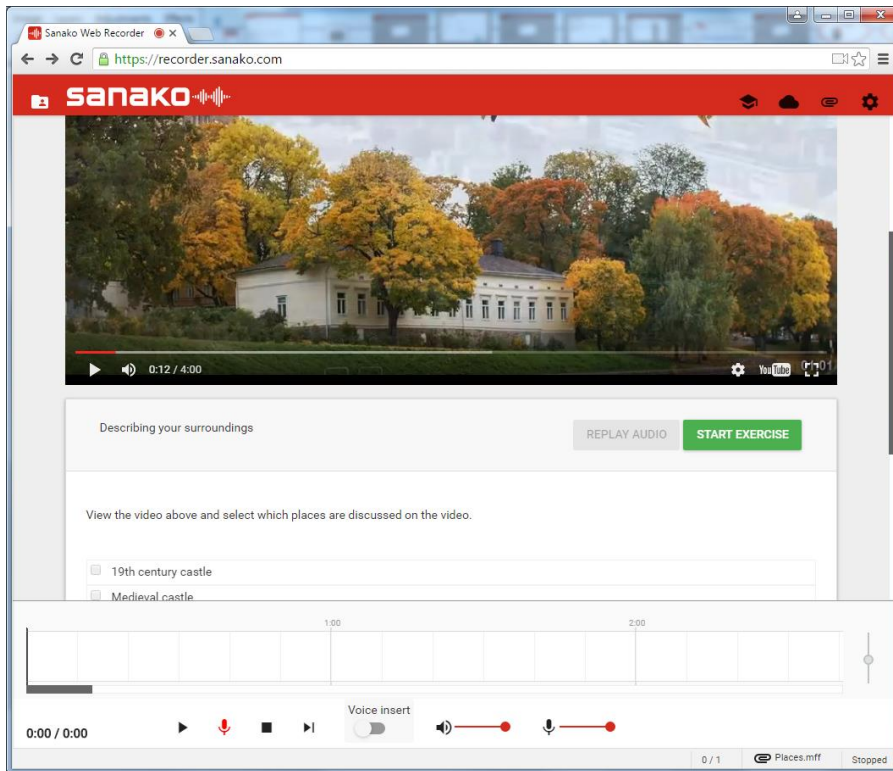
Sanako Content Editor

Overview

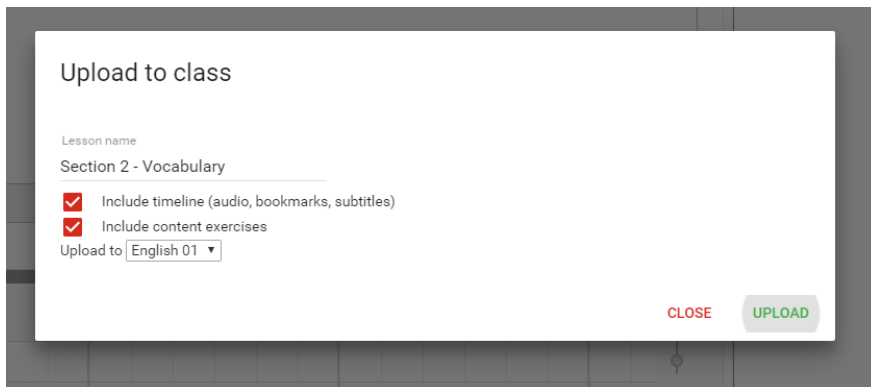
Sanako Content Editor is an online application that allows users to create exciting and diverse learning content for use with Sanako Study. Teachers can easily combine text, audio, video and images together for inspiring and interactive learning content.



You can build the content files using **ready exercise elements**. The different tasks include writing assignments, gap fill exercises, question and answer exercises, matching pairs and multiple choice questions. You can also add audio and video elements, subtitles, images and bookmarks to the content files.



The ready exercises are saved as **.mff files**. Teachers can copy the content files into their Study file area or share them via email for example.

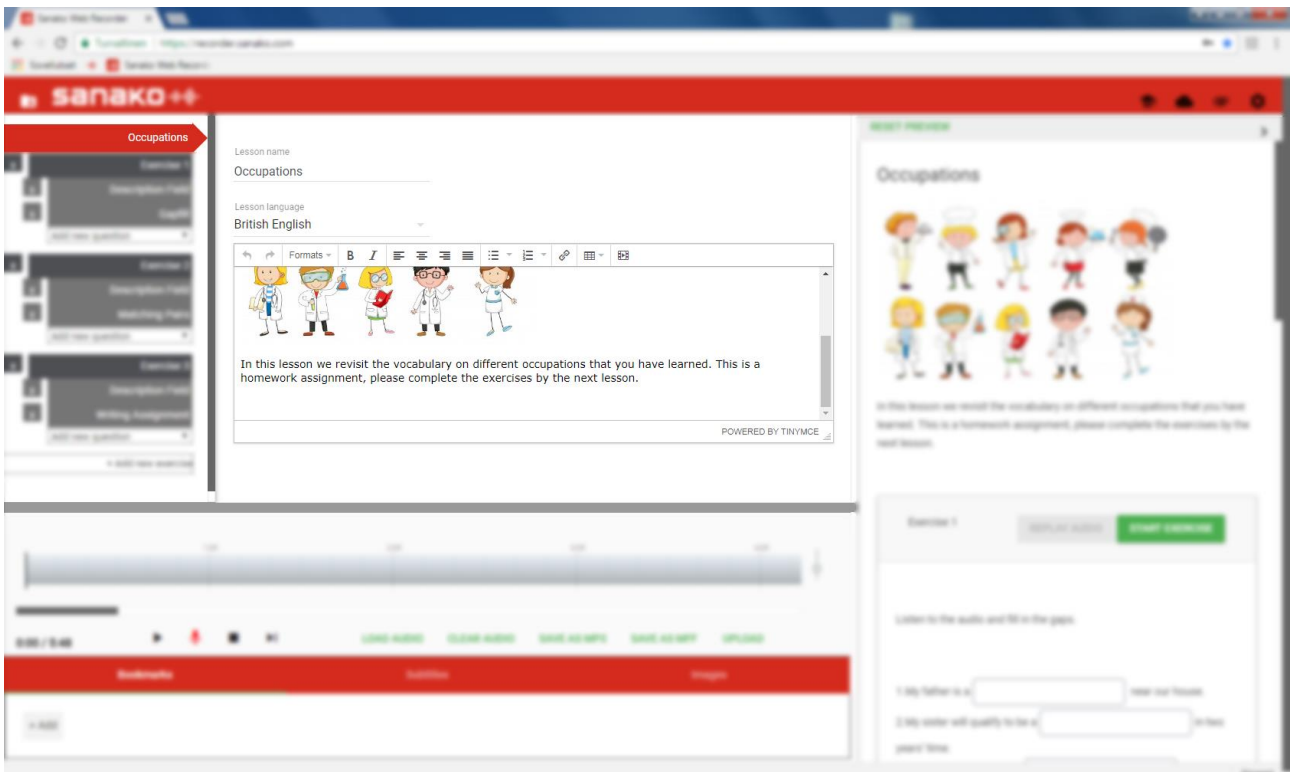


Sanako Content Editor can be accessed in the [Sanako Web Recorder](#). Teachers will also be able to use the Web Recorder to test their content files.

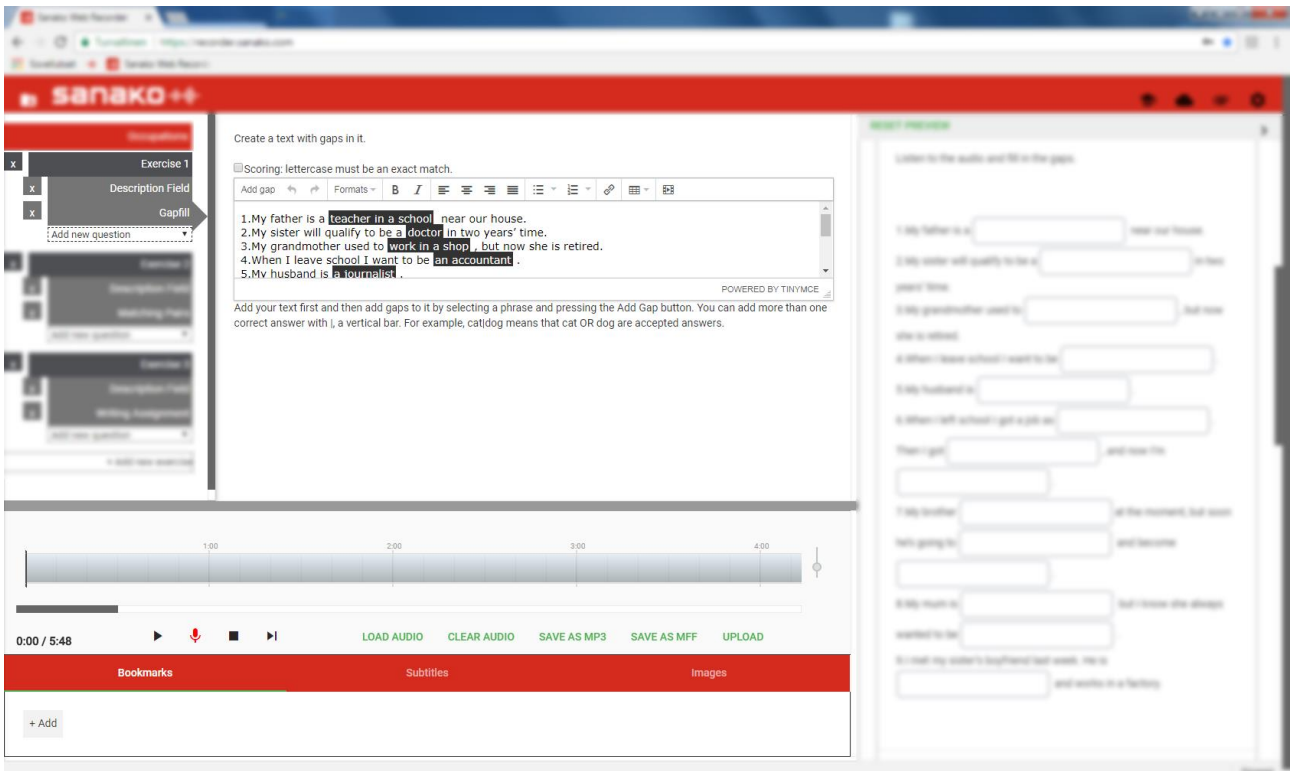
Example Use Case

Students have been learning basic vocabulary on different occupations in English. The teacher now wants to create a quick exercise where the students revisit some of this vocabulary and have to also write some of their own sentences on various professions.

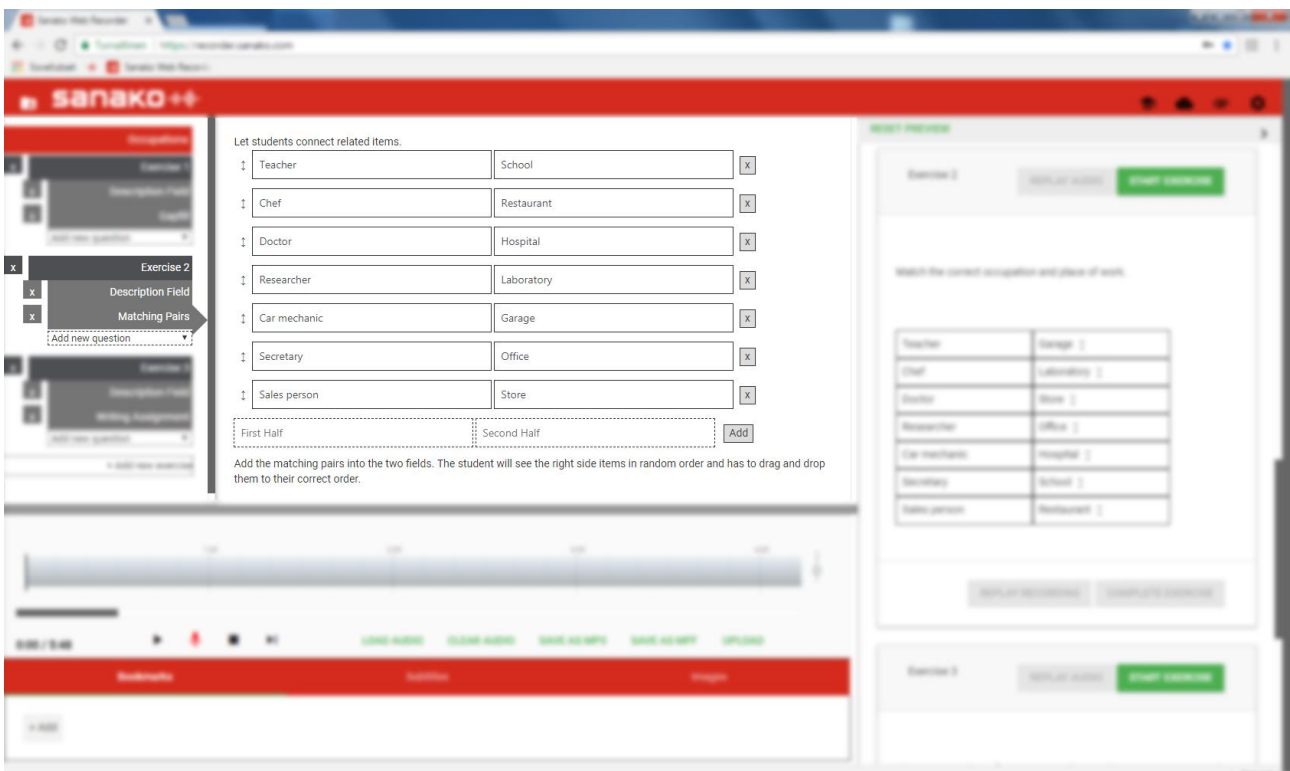
First, **create a new lesson** and add a **name and introduction** to the lesson telling the students what the lesson will include and require.



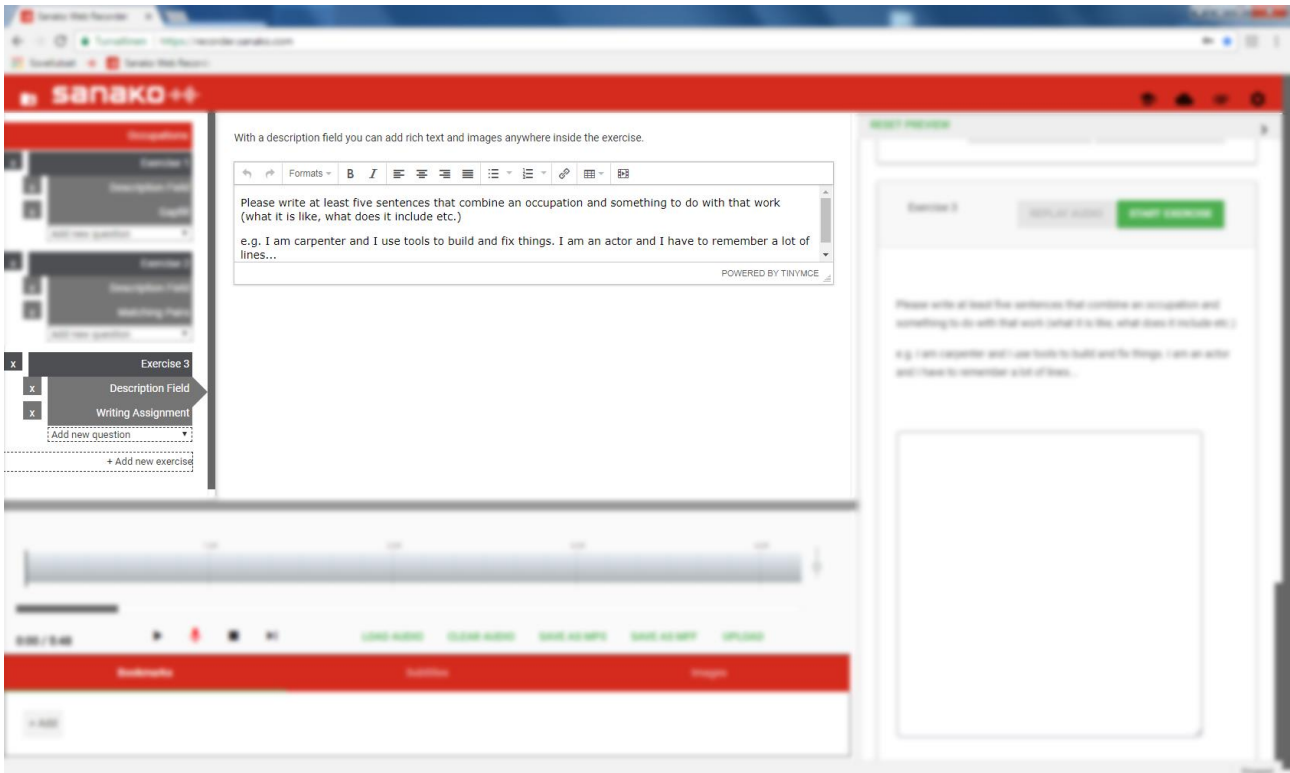
Add a **gap-filling exercise** where the students listen to audio and fill in missing words and phrases in a text. **Copy the text** into the exercise window. Then **select words and phrases** and **click Add Gap** to mark the gaps. Next, click **Load audio** and select the audio file.



Add a matching pairs exercise where the students connect matching occupations and workplaces. Add occupations to the left-hand column and the correct workplaces to the right-hand column. When students start the exercise they will see the entries in the right-hand column in random order.



The final exercise in the lesson is a free writing task where the students need to write five complete sentences. Type in the instructions telling the students what the sentences should include. The students will see these when starting the exercise.



When the exercise is ready, click **Save as MFF** and give a name for the lesson file. The file is saved into your Downloads folder.



You can then copy the content file to your Study file area and share it to students.
